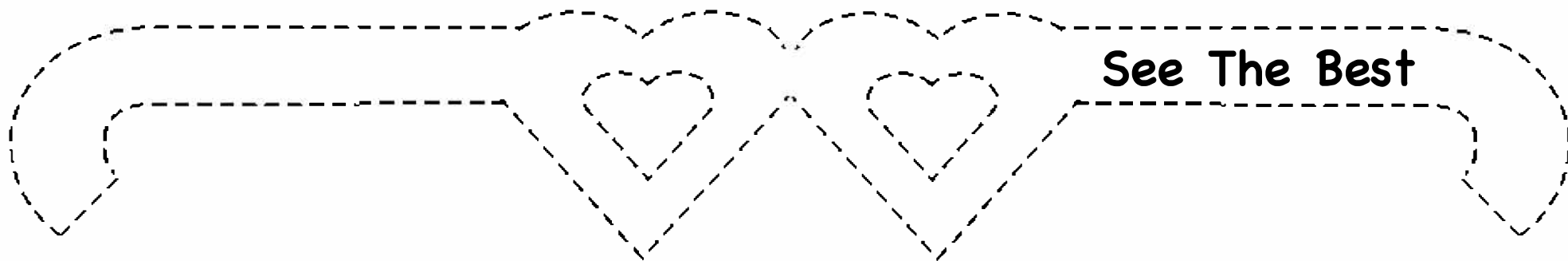




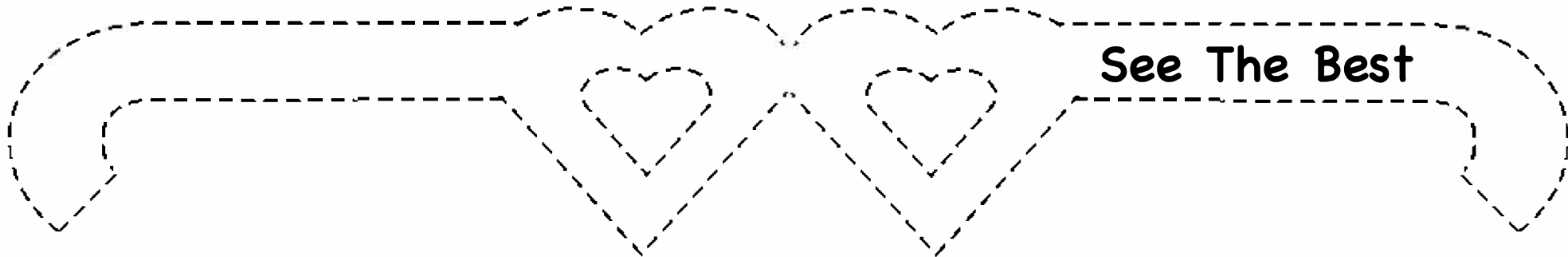
Shubert's Heart-Shaped Glasses

Create heart-shaped glasses to help children practice positive intent (seeing the best in others) as they read Shubert Sees the Best.

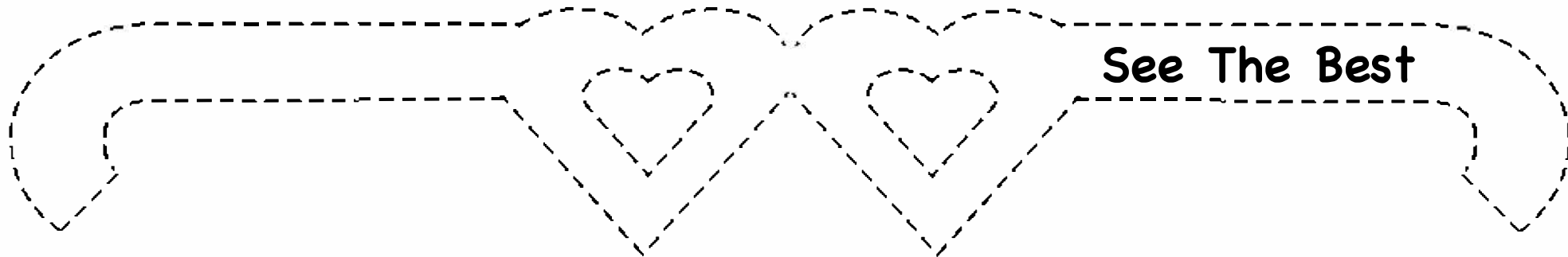

Once decorated, put the glasses on and have a class or family meeting to talk about what it means to see the best in others.
